### **SUBJECT: Greeley-Weld County Airport passes third inspection**

The Greeley-Weld County Airport has passed its third recent inspection of airport facilities by various entities, with zero deficiencies discovered. The airport was first inspected on June 18<sup>th</sup> by a risk identification team from the airport's insurance provider. The results of that inspection determined that no changes or improvements were needed to any of the airports facilities or procedures, a rarity in the insurance industry. A safety inspection of the airport was performed by the State of Colorado Division of Aeronautics on July 3<sup>rd</sup>. No safety or operational concerns arose from that inspection, and the inspectors from the State of Colorado noted the airport as being in "great shape". The final inspection came on July 25<sup>th</sup>, when the Federal Aviation Administration conducted its annual compliance inspection of the airport. Zero deficiencies were discovered during the inspection, and the FAA noted how good a condition the airport facilities were in.

Airport Manager Michael Reisman noted that it is extremely unusual to have three such inspections all take place in the same year. All three inspections were conducted independent of each other. Each inspection focused on different aspects of the airports facilities, operations, and procedures, and each resulted in the inspecting entity determining that the airport was doing an exceptional job of meeting its obligations to safety, regulatory requirements, and the reduction of risk hazards that may be inherent to such facilities. The results of these inspections are consistent with the goals of the Greeley-Weld County Airport Authority, in operating and maintaining the airport facility to the highest safety and operational standards.
