GREELEY-WELD COUNTY AIRPORT ISSUED CLEAN BILL OF HEALTH

The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) on Friday, January 6th, conducted an airport wide safety compliance inspection of the Greeley-Weld County Airport. The inspection focused on the condition of the airport as it relates to the safe operation of aircraft, and for compliance with all FAA regulations. The FAA conducted detailed inspections of the airports runways and taxiways, including critical runway and taxiway pavement markings, airfield lighting systems, surface conditions, including the on-going maintenance performed by the airport, and verified the calibration of certain navigation aids used by aircraft to land at the airport.

Upon completion of the inspection, the FAA issued the airport a “clean bill of health”, indicating that there were no violations of FAA regulations, and no safety related issues concerning the condition and maintenance of the airport.

The Greeley-Weld County Airport Authority employs a full time Airport Maintenance Division, which is responsible for the overall condition and upkeep of the airports runway and taxiway system, as well as buildings, grounds, and equipment maintenance. The Maintenance Division staff is also responsible for airport snow removal, and is cross-trained to perform aircraft rescue and firefighting duties.
